

## "Eat Me" Cake

Purple felt for A and C, 1 sheet
Brown felt for B and D, 1 sheet
Embroidery floss in white, purple, and brown
Thread
Stuffing
Embroider Needle
Sewing machine/Sewing needle

- 1.) Gather materials and print out template/pattern.
- 2.) Cut shapes out of template and pin shapes to felt. Cut felt pieces. (Remember to cut three pieces of trim (C).) Use pencil to write "Eat Me" on piece (A). Embroider words in white floss. (Note: nobody's perfect, so don't worry too much about neatness at this part.)
- 3.)(Making the bottom) Using brown floss, sew the inner arch of piece (D) to the circumference of piece (B) using a blanket stitch. After attaching the bottom, sew the seam running up the side of the cupcake and tie off.
- 4.) (Attaching the top) Using the purple floss, attach the top of the cupcake to the body, leaving a finger's with open. (Do not tie off.) Stuff cupcake, then sew the opening shut, tying off and weaving tail in.
- 5.) (Trim) Take the three strips for the trim (C) and stack them on each other. Using a sewing machine (or, if you are hand sewing, very tight small stitches), sew a straight line lengthwise, down the center of all three pieces. Afterwards, trim a quart inch from stitch mark on both sides, leave the trim a half inch wide. Fluff the pieces to and slightly twist to give the look of "piped frosting." Carefully sew trim to the out rim of the top of the cupcake, gently twisting the trim as you sew. (Be sure to keep your stitches hidden!) Finish off with small knot.
